#### **1 RULES**

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing and special regulations of Yachting Australia and The International Access Dingy Association class rules
- 1.2** Racing rule 86.1 will be changed as follows:
- 1.3** Under rule 86.1(b), in the definition Zone the distance is changed to two hull lengths.

#### **2 ADVERTISING**

- 2.1** Advertising will be restricted to Category C.Event
- 2.2** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

#### **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the Access 2.3 & 303 class boats
- 3.2** Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached forms and sending it, together with the required fee, by 5.00pm 28<sup>th</sup> February
- 3.3** Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the race committee

## **THE COURSES**

**11** The courses to be sailed will be as Trapezoid

## **12 PENALTY SYSTEM**

**12.1** For the rules 44.1 and 44.2 is changed so that the One-Turn alternative penalty will apply which shall include one track and one gybe in the same direction.

**12.2** Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

## **13 SCORING**

**13.1** The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.

**13.2** 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

(a) When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **14 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## **15 PRIZES** Prizes will be given as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> place in all divisions with 5 or more entries

Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organising Authority

## **16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4,

Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **17 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5 million per event or the equivalent.

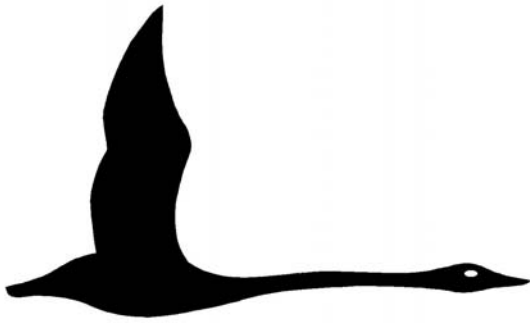
